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Program Overview

How It Works:

- Stop in at any South Kingstown Public Library branch to sign up and get a tracking sheet.
- Every time you or someone else reads a book to your child, color a spot on the sheet.
- When you complete the sheet, turn it in at the library.

Remember, if you read the same book over and over again, it counts each time! Also, stories read to your child at school, storytime...or anywhere all count!

Reading Milestones

Every 50 books you read, you get a sticker!

At 250, 500, 750 books, get a small surprise!

At 1,000 books, get a certificate and a free book!

Art and Reading

Some picture book authors have very distinct styles of illustration...

think Eric Carle or Michael Hall.

Have an art and reading day with your child. Read a book by Eric Carle, then make tissue paper collage art afterwards. Read a book by Michael Hall, then make art from shapes. You could also read a favorite book, and make art inspired by the story itself!
