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## Program Overview

### How It Works:

- Stop in at any South Kingstown Public Library branch to sign up and get a tracking sheet.
- Every time you or someone else reads a book to your child, color a spot on the sheet.
- When you complete the sheet, turn it in at the library.

Remember, if you read the same book over and over again, it counts each time! Also, stories read to your child at school, storytime...or anywhere all count!

### Reading Milestones

Every 50 books you read, you get a sticker!

At 250, 500, 750 books, get a small surprise!

At 1,000 books, get a certificate and a free book!

### Sharing Books with Babies

Since babies are still developing, sometimes they have trouble focusing. Board books can be good choices because of their often smaller size, sturdier pages, and simple pictures.

Board books are perfect for letting your baby explore on their own as they develop the motor skills needed to turn the pages of a book.
