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Program Overview

How It Works:

- Stop in at any South Kingstown Public Library branch to sign up and get a tracking sheet.
- Every time you or someone else reads a book to your child, color a spot on the sheet.
- When you complete the sheet, turn it in at the library.

Remember, if you read the same book over and over again, it counts each time! Also, stories read to your child at school, storytime...or anywhere all count!

Reading Milestones

Every 50 books you read, you get a sticker!

At 250, 500, 750 books, get a small surprise!

At 1,000 books, get a certificate and a free book!

Getting Ready to Read

- Songs help children hear all the sounds in words. Sing together!
- Children learn about language through play. Play together!
- Reading and writing go together! Let your child practice drawing, tracing, and coloring to help develop motor skill for writing.
- All children learn differently! The most important thing is to remember to have fun together while reading, playing, singing, and storytelling!
