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Program Overview

How It Works:

- Stop in at any South Kingstown Public Library branch to sign up and get a tracking sheet.
- Every time you or someone else reads a book to your child, color a spot on the sheet.
- When you complete the sheet, turn it in at the library.

Remember, if you read the same book over and over again, it counts each time! Also, stories read to your child at school, storytime...or anywhere all count!

Reading Milestones

Every 50 books you read, you get a sticker!

At 250, 500, 750 books, get a small surprise!

At 1,000 books, get a certificate and a free book!

Singing helps develop listening and memory skills, and makes repetition easier for your children—it's easier to remember a short song than a short story!

From "The Wheels on the Bus" to "Twinkle, Twinkle, Little Star", "If You're Happy and You Know It" to "The Itsy Bitsy Spider", there are plenty of classic songs that can easily be shared with your child...even if you think you are musically challenged (trust us...your child won't notice if you can't sing perfectly!).
