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Program Overview

How It Works:

- Stop in at any South Kingstown Public Library branch to sign up and get a tracking sheet.
- Every time you or someone else reads a book to your child, color a spot on the sheet.
- When you complete the sheet, turn it in at the library.

Remember, if you read the same book over and over again, it counts each time! Also, stories read to your child at school, storytime...or anywhere all count!

Reading Milestones

Every 50 books you read, you get a sticker!

At 250, 500, 750 books, get a small surprise!

At 1,000 books, get a certificate and a free book!

Just like with independent readers, not every book you read aloud is going to be a hit with your child. If you notice he or she is restless or not paying attention to a story you are reading together, it's okay to set the book aside and try a different one. Really.

You can also switch it up and try asking your child how they would end the story you're reading, bringing out their creative storytelling telling.
