**Re: The Prout School proposed change to previously approved application for athletic field modifications.**

Dear Mr. Rabbitt:

Following the June 8, 2022 Technical Review Committee meeting, where the TRC requested that the Prout School supplement its submission to the TRC with photometric drawings showing the equivalence of the proposed Techline lighting system to the previously-approved Musco lighting system, Prout requested that Techline review the previously-submitted Musco drawings and create a set of photometric plans for the Techline system that provide the TRC an apples-to-apples comparison of the relevant data. They have done so.

Enclosed please find two (2) photometric drawings from Techline which depict, respectively, (a) the light scatter from the Techline system on a 30' grid out to the 150' line (as the Musco submission had shown) and (b) the light impact at the property line (as the Musco submission had shown). These photometric maps—when compared to the previously-submitted Musco maps—show that the Techline and Musco systems produce equivalent light uniformity on field, equivalent light scatter across the grid, and equivalent light leakage along the property line.

We request that the enclosed photometric maps be added to the TRC's file for this application and that the tabled matter from June 8, 2022 be placed on the July 13, 2022 TRC agenda.
