## Household Waste Disposal

Bagged Household Waste	Bulky Waste
 <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Each trash bag requires a refuse tag. Visibly place tag on bag prior to disposal.</li> <li>Tags cost \$2.00 each and are sold in sheets of 5. Tags purchases of less than 5 can be made in May and June of every year.</li> <li>Tags expire June 30th of each year.</li> <li>Tags can be purchased at the RHRTS or South Kingstown Town Hall.</li> <li>Bag volume is limited to 33 gallons and weight limit is 35 pounds.</li> </ul> <p>\$2.00/Tag</p>	 <p>A fee of 6¢/pound (\$5.00 minimum) will be charged for bulky items such as:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>furniture</li> <li>large household items</li> <li>construction/demolition material</li> </ul> <p>Single bulky items weighing 35 pounds or less may be placed in a bag and disposed of with a tag.</p> <p>6¢/Lb.</p>
Appliances *	Tires *
 <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li><b>Refrigerant (Freon) Appliance:</b> A flat fee of \$18.75 will be charged for the disposal of <u>each</u> refrigerant appliance (this includes refrigerators, freezers, air conditioners, dehumidifiers, etc.)</li> <li><b>Non-Refrigerant Appliance:</b> A flat fee of \$6.20 will be charged for the disposal of <u>each</u> non-refrigerant appliance.</li> </ul>	 <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Each tire 18" in diameter and under (no rim) costs \$7.00 each.</li> <li>Tires 19" in diameter or greater (no rim) costs \$13.00 each.</li> <li>Charge for car tires on the rim cost \$9.25 each.</li> </ul>

<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Car Battery - \$2.00*</li> <li>Propane Tanks 25 lbs. or less - \$5.00 Propane Tank 25 - 100 lbs. - \$20.00*</li> </ul>	

\*Commodities with an asterisk\* will be assessed at a 6¢/Lb. fee in addition to the commodity charge if commingled in a mixed load.

## Yard Waste Disposal Guidelines

Leaves & Grass	Residential Yard Waste & Brush
 <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Yard Waste Tags may be purchased to dispose of leaves and grass clippings in brown paper yard waste bags.</li> <li>Individual Yard Waste Tags may be purchased at the RHRTS or South Kingstown Town Hall for \$1.25.</li> <li>Tags expire June 30th of each year.</li> <li><b>No plastic bags please.</b></li> </ul> <p>\$1.25 Tag</p>	 <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Large brush, bulk quantities of leaves, tree limbs and trunks less than 6" in diameter may be discharged at a rate of 3.5¢/pound (\$5.00 minimum).</li> <li>No branches over 6" in diameter.</li> <li>No branches longer than 4 feet in length.</li> </ul> <p>3.5 ¢/Lb.</p>

# Residential Area Recycling

## MIX ALL YOUR RECYCLABLES TOGETHER

### Mixed Paper

- Writing and Computer Paper, Phone Books, Magazines,
- Catalogues, Junk Mail, Paperback Books, Wrapping Paper

### Newspapers

- All newspapers, ads and inserts

### Thin Cardboard

- Cereal and pasta boxes, juice boxes, milk, soup cartons, shoe and tissue boxes, egg cartons.

### Corrugated Cardboard

- Boxes and other corrugated cardboard, brown bags
- Breakdown and flatten larger pieces.

### Metal Cans and Foil

- Vegetable, Soda, Soup, Coffee Cans, Empty Aerosol Cans
- Clean Foil and Pie Plates

### Plastics and Glass

- Jars & Jugs
- Bottles - soda, shampoo, water

### NEW Acceptable Recyclables!

- Tubs - Yogurt, Margarine, Plastic Cups and Food Containers.
- All plastics Containers up to 5 Gallons in Size
- **Mostly** clean pizza boxes



## Other Residential Recyclables Disposable at the Transfer Station

Mattress/Box Springs



Deposit these recyclable items in designated containers. Damaged or soiled **mattresses or box springs** are charged at the rate of \$60.00 per piece.

Ask the RHRTS attendant for assistance if needed.



### RECYCLING DON'TS

Please do **NOT** Recycle any of the following in the Residential Recycling Area or in your Toter or Bin:

- Refrigerated and Frozen Food Boxes - butter, beer, soda or TV dinner boxes
- Rigid plastics like toys, lawn chairs, furniture (please place in Rigid Plastic container)
- Household Hazardous Waste - oil based paint, rechargeable batteries, etc. (bring to a local Eco-Depot)
- Sharps - injectables, needles, and other medical waste (bring to a local Eco-Depot)
- **Greasy** pizza boxes (mostly clean pizza boxes may be recycled)
- Styrofoam (can be recycled in the Small Vehicle Area at RIRRC in Johnston.)
- Shredded Paper is no longer accepted with recyclables (bring to a local shredding event or RIRRC)
