for a **Special Use Permit** under the Zoning Ordinance as follows:

The applicant is seeking to replace the existing seasonal cottage and deck. The cottage and will be increased in size by 150 square feet, the maximum allowed. The new cottage is proposed to be 518 square feet and the deck will be replaced in the same size of the existing 192 square feet. The required separation between adjacent cottages will be in compliance with the zoning standards. Lot size is 50.2 Acres. **A Special Use Permit is required per Zoning Ordinance Section 203 (Special Use Permit for Addition, Enlargement, Expansion or Intensification), Section 608 (Coastal Community Overlay District) and Section 907 (Standards of Relief).** Owner of cottage 10E9 is Celeste Helterline on property owned by Matunuck Beach Properties, located at 240 Cards Pond Road, South Kingstown, RI, Assessor's Map 92-1, Lot 9-107 and is zoned R200.

Enclosed is the Legal Notice for your hearing with the Zoning Board of Review that **must be sent Certified Mail, Return Receipt Requested** to all of the following:

- All property owners within the 200-foot radius of the property in question whether within the Town or an adjacent town.
- The South Kingstown Town Council, 180 High Street, Wakefield, RI; and
- If the 200-foot radius of the property in question extends into an adjacent Town, to that Town Council.

Ownership must be checked and verified the day of mailing through the Town Clerk's New Vision Land Evidence program. This can be done on-line at:

These notices **must** be mailed no later than fourteen (14) days prior to the hearing. **Failure to mail these notices by the legal deadline will result in your application being continued to the next available hearing date.**

The Post Office will date stamp the green and white certified proof of mailing receipts and all of these receipts along with the completed and notarized affidavit of mailing must be returned to the Building and Zoning Office prior to the hearing. **Failure to provide this proof of mailing documentation will also result in your application being continued to the next available hearing date.**

Please note the date of the hearing and be sure that you or someone with written authorization to act on your behalf is present to explain the application.
