EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT DIRECTOR EXECUTIVE ORDER 2020-06 (SECOND AMENDMENT)

WHEREAS, on March 9, 2020, the State of Rhode Island Governor Gina M. Raimondo issued Executive Order 20-03 declaring a state of emergency due to the outbreak of COVID-19; and the Town Council of the Town of South Kingstown declared a state of emergency through an emergency ordinance enacted on March 15, 2020, and extended through September 14, 2020 to deal with the COVID-19 pandemic; and

WHEREAS, the Town Council delegated emergency authority to the Town Manager to take measures he deems necessary in order to protect public health and safety in response to the pandemic; and

WHEREAS, the emergency power delegated, and state of emergency declared by the Town Council has been continued in effect inclusive of the current date; and

WHEREAS, social distancing is the most effective and important tool available to combat the spread of the pandemic:

NOW THEREFORE, the following emergency measures are enacted as of Thursday, July 16, 2020:


1. Parking in the beach areas, as defined herein, is hereby prohibited during the state of emergency. Violators will be towed.
2. "Beach areas," as used in this executive order, includes the following locations/roadways:
 - a. Succotash Road, entire length;
 - b. Jerusalem;
 - c. the State Pier; and
 - d. All roadways adjacent to the enumerated roadways/places listed herein.
3. For private residences or businesses that have not been closed pursuant to Governor Raimondo's executive orders, parking in the above-listed beach areas will not be prohibited if sufficient off-street parking is not available for occupants or customers thereof.
4. This order shall not be construed to deprive residents of parking if sufficient off-street parking is not available for occupants.
5. The fine for parking in any area prohibited by this executive order is hereby increased to one hundred and fifty dollars (\$150) per violation.
6. This executive order shall remain in effect until September 14, 2020 unless terminated prior to that date by a subsequent order. This executive order may be further extended if necessary, by a subsequent executive order. To the extent that this executive order is in any manner inconsistent with any prior executive order, the terms of this executive order shall govern.
